Federally facilitated marketplaces will use the 2015 Federal Poverty Guidelines to calculate cost-assistance for open enrollment November 1, 2015 - January 31, 2016.

The fee for not having health coverage in 2016

If you don't have health insurance in 2016, you'll pay the **higher** of these two amounts:

- **2.5% of your yearly household income**
- **\$695 per person (\$347.50 per child under 18)** The maximum penalty per family using this method is \$2,085.

If you're uninsured for just part of the year, 1/12 of the yearly penalty applies to each month you're uninsured.

If you have a gap in coverage that is less than three consecutive months, you don't have to make a payment.
